## MINISTRY LHIN ACCOUNTABILITY AGREEMENT ("MLAA") 2015-18

THIS AMENDING AGREEMENT (the "Agreement") effective as of April 1, 2016.

## **BETWEEN:**

Her Majesty the Queen in right of Ontario, as represented by the Minister of Health and Long-Term Care ("MOHLTC")

- and -

## Central West Local Health Integration Network ("LHIN")

**WHEREAS** the parties entered into an accountability agreement for fiscal years 2015-2018 pursuant to section 18 of the *Local Health System Integration Act, 2006* ("MLAA");

AND WHEREAS the parties wish to amend the MLAA on the terms and conditions set out herein.

**NOW THEREFORE** in consideration of the mutual covenants and agreements contained in this Agreement and other good and valuable consideration (the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged by each of the parties), the parties agree as follows:

- **1.0 Definitions.** Except as otherwise defined in this Agreement, all terms shall have the meaning ascribed to them in the MLAA.
- 2.0 Amendments.
- 2.1 <u>Agreed Amendments</u>. The parties agree that the MLAA shall be amended as set out in this Article 2.
- 2.2 Paragraph 2 of Schedule 1: General is amended by deleting the date "September 25, 2014" and replacing it with the date "September 23, 2016".
- 2.3 Paragraph 7 of Schedule 1: General is amended by deleting "and Toolkit", and deleting the date "February 2011" and replacing it with the date "June 2016".
- 2.4 Footnote 1 of Schedule 1: General is amended by deleting <a href="http://www.lhincollaborative.ca/uploadedFiles/LHIN\_Collaborative/LHIN%20Community%20Engagement%20Guidelines%20and%20Toolkit%20-%20February%202011%20-%20FINAL.pdf">http://www.lhincollaborative.ca/uploadedFiles/LHIN\_Collaborative/LHIN%20Community%20Engagement%20Guidelines%20and%20Toolkit%20-%20February%202011%20-%20FINAL.pdf</a>.

- 2.5 Paragraph 2 of Schedule 4: Funding and Allocations is amended by deleting the date "2015-16" and replacing it with the date "2016-17", and by deleting "August 31, 2015" and replacing it with "August 31, 2016".
- 2.6 Paragraph 3(a) of Schedule 4: Funding and Allocations is amended by deleting "September 25, 2015" and replacing it with "September 26, 2016", by deleting the date "2015-16" and replacing it with "2016-2017" and by deleting "August 31, 2015" and replacing it with "August 31, 2016".
- 2.7 Tables 1, 1a, 2, 2a, 3 and 3a of Schedule 4: Funding and Allocations are updated and replaced with the Tables 1, 1a, 2, 2a, 3, and 3a attached to this Amending Agreement as Appendix A.
- 3.0 **Effective Date**. The Parties agree that the amendments set out in Article 2 shall take effect on April 1, 2016. All other terms of the MLAA shall remain in full force and effect.
- 4.0 **Governing Law.** This Agreement and the rights, obligations and relations of the Parties will be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the Province of Ontario and the federal laws of Canada applicable therein.
- 5.0 **Counterparts.** This Agreement may be executed in any number of counterparts, each of which will be deemed an original, but all of which together will constitute one and the same instrument.
